INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS:

Applications to participate in the 2015 Wake Forest Christmas Parade are now being accepted. Interested participants should submit their application by mail to Wake Forest Downtown, Inc. Entries postmarked by October 15 will be considered for inclusion based on the number of entries needed for each category. Accepted entrants will be notified via email by October 31. Payment for entry must be received by November 14 to secure a position in the parade. Parade packets for accepted participants will be mailed on November 27. This packet will include vehicle passes, parking information and other pertinent details for the event.

The Wake Forest Christmas Parade is a fun-filled event for thousands of participants and spectators. Parade instructions and rules are designed to remind participants that sometimes even the most innocent actions can provoke significant problems in a crowded area. The rules are in place to ensure that we have an orderly, safe and joyful parade. Please communicate these rules to all members of your parade entry.

Applications must be postmarked by October 15.

Instructions for Participants

SATURDAY DECEMBER 12, 2015, 1:00 PM

REQUIRED SIGN IN

- WHEN** Registration begins at 10:00 am and promptly closes at 12:00 pm.
- WHERE** Entry for parade participants will be at the intersection of Wait Avenue and South Franklin Street only. Vehicles entering from the 98 Bypass/Calvin Jones Boulevard will not have access to the check-in and line-up area. The Parade registration checkpoint is located on Holding Avenue.
- WHO** One representative from your group must sign in. All vehicles participating in the parade must be in the staging area by 12:00 pm and a driver must remain with vehicles at all times.

VEHICLE PASSES & PARKING

You must have your vehicle pass ready to show at the South Franklin Street & Holding Avenue roundabout checkpoint. Vehicles without passes will not be permitted past the checkpoint.

Carpool parking passes for the staging area and Drop & Go participant drop-off passes are limited. Each group has been designated passes based on availability. Please note, requests for additional passes cannot be accommodated, however on-street parking and municipal parking lots are available throughout downtown. Please review the parade route map for street closings.

LINE-UP

- WHEN** All participants must be on site and lined-up by 12:30 pm.
- WHERE** Beginning at the intersection of Elm Avenue and South White Street, wrapping around onto Holding Avenue. Each group's line-up position is determined by parade officials. Due to the overwhelming number of entries, individual requests for line-up positions cannot be accommodated. Line-up positions may be posted online a few days preceding the parade but are subject to change without notice. Confirmed line-up positions will be given upon check-in the day of the parade.

PARADE ROUTE

The parade will begin at the intersection of Elm Avenue and South White Street, continue north on South White Street, turn right at East Wait Avenue, then right again on Brooks Street. The Parade will end at Renaissance Place after the intersection of Brooks Street and Elm Avenue. Do not stop at the intersection to unload—please continue into the Renaissance Place parking lot as directed by parade officials.

PARADE RULES

Please communicate these rules to everyone in your group. Failure to comply with these rules and/or instructions from parade officials could result in removal from the parade line-up this year and future years. Thank you for your understanding and compliance.

- There is only one Santa allowed in the parade, provided by Wake Forest Downtown.
- All hands and feet must be kept inside vehicles and floats at all times and everyone must remain seated. Floats must come to a complete stop before participants disembark. Absolutely no one may jump from a float while it is in motion.
- Do not leave the parade line-up until the parade ends at Renaissance Place.
- The maximum number of riders on any float is 20 (total number of adults and children).
- Adult supervision for all children under the age of 14 is required at all times in the staging area and during the parade, in addition to the driver of the vehicle.
- Be conscious of participant vehicles while in the parade line-up. Parade volunteers coordinate this event and are not responsible for children.
- **CANDY MAY NOT BE THROWN TO THE PUBLIC AT ANY TIME.** Such action can harm those watching the parade and provides an unnecessary danger to children who can be run over by parade vehicles while trying to collect candy. Candy and promotional material may be handed out to the crowd by your representatives walking alongside of your entry.
- Loud noises such as sirens and motorcycle revving are discouraged since these can frighten children.
- We request that all teams, troops and tribes please wear their uniforms or matching attire and carry a sign or banner that identifies the group.
- **FESTIVE ATTIRE IS REQUIRED** for all parade participants including parents and chaperones.
- In order to prevent gaps in the parade, participants must continue moving forward and are not permitted to stop and perform.
- The Wake Forest Christmas Parade is a rain or shine event. Please ensure your organization has appropriate weather related provisions.
- Homemade floats are especially encouraged and appreciated by spectators.
