**BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS CANDIDATES' FORUM  
TO AIR ON COMMUNITY CHANNEL 10**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – October 4, 2011** – Wake Forest residents who are unable to attend the Oct. 11 Board of Commissioners Candidates' Forum can watch the event live on Community Channel 10 or on the Town's website at [www.wakeforestnc.gov](http://www.wakeforestnc.gov).

The Wake Forest Area Chamber of Commerce will host the forum in preparation for the Nov. 8 election. Local attorney Sue Anthony will serve as the moderator.

Featuring the eight candidates vying for three seats on the Wake Forest Board of Commissioners, the forum will offer business and community leaders, residents, and interested parties an opportunity to meet the candidates and learn their views on a wide range of topics. Candidates will be asked questions about their solutions to pressing local challenges and how they will shape Wake Forest's future.

The event will be held in the Wake Forest Town Hall Board Chambers, 301 S. Brooks St., on Tuesday, Oct. 11, beginning at 6:30 p.m. The event is free and open to the public and seats will be filled on a first-come basis.

Beginning Wednesday, Oct. 12, the unedited forum will be rebroadcast daily on Community Channel 10 at noon and 7 p.m. through Election Day. The 2011 Board of Commissioners Candidates' Forum is the only forum for board of commissioners to be aired this year on Community Channel 10.

Community Channel 10 is the Town's government access channel that serves the residents of Wake Forest. Produced by the Town of Wake Forest Communications Department, Community Channel 10 is available to residents and businesses that subscribe to Time-Warner cable TV service. The information channel operates 24 hours per day and provides information about various programs, services, upcoming meetings, and special events sponsored by the Town of Wake Forest.
