## Facility Facts

**Year built:** 1986  
**Size:** 4,250 sq. ft.  
**Property:** one acre  
**Parking:** small parking lot and plentiful parking along N. Taylor Street

The Alston-Massenburg Center was named in 1987 in memory of George Massenburg, a former Town of Wake Forest employee, and Edward Alston, a life-time resident of the town.


**Renovation:** In 2012, the Town of Wake Forest fully renovated the Alston-Massenburg Center adding 1,350 square feet to the facility. The \$650,000 renovation was funded through the town's Capital Improvements Plan and a \$165,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) awarded to Wake County from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Improvements included a new roof, energy efficient windows and doors, as well as a revamped layout that now includes meeting space, a larger kitchen, bathrooms and a performance area.



## Amenities

- **Large meeting room:** podium, performance stage, theater curtains, automated projector and screen  
*seats 112 people without tables or 66 people with tables*
- Interior and exterior bathrooms
- Lobby with check-in counter
- Kitchen with stove, microwave, refrigerator, oven and sink
- 24 tables and 126 chairs available
- Adjoining Taylor Street Park with playground and a picnic shelter
- Convenient to the Wake Forest Bus Loop
