



## Project Description

The Town of Wake Forest proposes to implement a “Complete Streets” vision along Stadium Drive from Glencoe Drive to N. Wingate Street, a distance of approximately 1.1 miles. Stadium Drive is currently two lanes with a center left-turn lane in some areas. This project would extend the center turn lane for the full length of the corridor, add curb and gutter, and pave wider shoulders on both sides of the road. A roundabout is planned at the intersection of Stadium Drive and N. Wingate Street. Additional turn lanes would be marked at intersections and driveways where needed.

Pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Glencoe Drive to the bridge over Richland Creek include a 10-foot wide multi-use path on the south side and a 5-foot wide sidewalk on the north side. From the bridge to N. Wingate Street there will be sidewalks on both sides of the road. Shared-lane bicycle markings (called “sharrows”) will be added to the travel lanes along the entire corridor. Sharrows increase a driver’s awareness of the presence of bicyclists and reduce the likelihood of bicycling in the wrong direction. The project also will include two pedestrian refuge islands, high visibility crosswalks, and accessible transit stops. In addition to the Complete Streets elements on Stadium Drive, this project includes resurfacing North Avenue from N. Wingate Street to N. Main Street.

## Status of the Project

The Town of Wake Forest received a grant in 2012 from the Locally Administered Projects Program (LAPP). It is listed as Project U-5515 in the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The project design is anticipated to be complete in the fall of 2014. Construction of the project will begin once additional funding has been identified.


