FALL BASEBALL & SOFTBALL REGISTRATION

WAKE FOREST, NC – June 1, 2010 – Registration for the Wake Forest Parks & Recreation Department's youth and adult fall baseball and softball leagues is underway through 5 p.m. Friday, June 25.

Youth leagues are offered for boys and girls ages 6-16. A participant's eligibility is determined by his or her age on April 30, 2010, and a birth certificate is required for new participants.

Registration forms for all youth leagues are available at www.wakeforestnc.gov/residents/parksrecreation_youthathletics.aspx or may be picked up at Town Hall. The in-town registration fee is \$40 and the out-of-town fee is \$80.

Players in every youth league except "Coach Pitch" must participate in a draft to determine team placement. The Parks & Recreation Department will conduct drafts for each league in August and in July will mail all registrants a postcard with draft/placement information. A birth certificate is required for all first-time participants.

Registration forms for the Men's Fall, Fall Co-Recreational, and Co-Recreational Church Softball Leagues are available online at www.wakeforestnc.gov/residents/parksrecreation_adultathletics.aspx and at Town Hall.

The Men's Fall Softball League is limited to Class E teams and lower. League play is scheduled to begin the week of Aug. 16, and games will be played on Monday and Wednesday evenings. The entry fee is \$550 per team.

The Fall Co-Recreational Softball League will also begin the week of Aug. 16, with games on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. Entry fee is \$550 per team.

The Co-Recreational Church Softball League will begin the week of July 12. Games will be played on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. The entry fee is \$550 per team.
