The Wake Forest Cultural Arts Association (WFAA) is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit all volunteer organization whose purpose is to develop, promote and coordinate the arts, thereby preserving the cultural heritage of Wake Forest and its surroundings and sustaining its cultural life. The organization started in 1988 with initiatives from the Town of Wake Forest and the United Arts Council.

- Wake Forest Singers Concert – Sunday – April 13, 2008 – 7PM – Franklin Academy
- Six Sundays in Spring Concert Series – Sundays – 5 to 7PM – Wake Forest Birthplace Grounds
Dates are April 20, April 27, May 4, May 11, May 18 and May 25, 2008

We partner with other organizations to present the Autumn Arts Festival, Artists Studio Tour, the Garden Club and Historic Homes Tours and the Town's Centennial Celebration planned for 2009.
