CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

a. Adopt-a-Trail Program

Candace and Jan shared information from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Grant and Adopt-a-Trail meeting held on December 4th. The following people were present: Candace Davis, Holly Spring, Susan Simpson, Jan Ammons, Tim Nau, and Pete Schmutz. Town staff is applying for a \$50,000 EPA Environmental Education grant. The grant award money will be used to fund the educational programs, equipment, and trail maintenance supplies for the Adopt-a-Trail Program. The award winners will be notified in July 2010.
