CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Christopher Dall at 9:05 a.m.

MINUTES

ACTION: Caroline Jordan made a motion to approve the minutes. Felicia Fotsch seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

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ITEMS FOR AGENDA FROM BOARD MEMBERS

Ms. Simpson requested that two items be placed under New Business - item b - a reception invitation, and item c - Easter Egg Hunt. Both items were accepted and added to the agenda.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

OLD BUSINESS

The first item of business was a follow-up discussion of the board's possible booth at Meet in the Street. Ms. Simpson reported that she has not heard anything from the Chamber Director about the board switching their plans. She asked Commissioner Stinnett if she could make a call or visit on behalf of the board and try and get a response. Commissioner Stinnett said that she would go by the Chamber office on Monday. The board wants to work with them at Meet in the Street and not just go off on our own. Ms. Simpson stated that for now the group should plan on having the booth and being at the event. Kyra Daniel had reported that she had a lot of face painting supplies on hand and Ms. Simpson asked her to check and make sure she didn't need anything else. Ms. Simpson said that she would get a table and some chairs for the booth and a cash box with some change. She recommended to the group that they ask for \$1 donation for the Interfaith Food Shuttle program. A sign up sheet was passed around to sign up for two 3.5 hour shifts. Ms. Simpson mentioned that Felicia Fotsch was the only one who signed up for the 9:30 - 1 p.m. shift and that she could not run the booth by herself. Christopher Dall said that he would call Davis Allen and Darnesha Adams and check their availability. Both Ms. Simpson and Commissioner Stinnett reminded the board that this is their event and they need to decide whether they can commit to an all day schedule.

Ms. Simpson said that she had received all but one payment for the brick paver in the plaza for the new Town Hall. She said that she would contact that person and get the \$10. She
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thanked the group for participating in this Centennial event and the history of their Town.

NEW BUSINESS

Gabriel Lopez asked the group if they still wanted someone from the Interfaith Food Shuttle to come to one of our last meetings and speak on the “backpack buddies” program. The group decided to have them come to the May 16th meeting and have the check presentation then too.

Ms. Simpson mentioned the retirement of Joyce Wilson, Town Clerk and the reception the Town is hosting on Tuesday, April 21 from 6-7 p.m. in the lobby of Town Hall. All advisory board members are being invited since Ms. Wilson indirectly works with all of the boards. Commissioner Stinnett stated that their school attire was OK to wear to the reception.

Ms. Simpson mentioned the email she had sent regarding volunteers for her department’s Easter Egg Hunts on Saturday, March 28. Megan Levy and Christopher Dall volunteered to help at the first two hunts. Kyra and Kiana Daniel said that they would check there schedule to see if they could help too. Ms. Simpson asked them to report to Cindy Ferguson at Holding Park around 12:45 p.m. The rain site is the Flaherty Park Community Center..
