### **CALL TO ORDER**

### **MINUTES**

**ACTION:** Austin Mooreman made a motion to approve the minutes. Kiana Daniel seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### **CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT**

Kyra Daniel gave a brief report on the State of the Town Address given February 22 by Mayor Vivian Jones. The following members were in attendance: Kyra Daniel, Kiana Daniel, Felicia Fotsch, and Holden McLemore. Kyra Daniel said that Mayor Jones talked about the accomplishments over the past year and about upcoming projects. She also mentioned the growth of the Town in the last ten years. Felicia Fotsch mentioned the accomplishments and the AAA Bond rating and the road improvements on S. Main Street. Kiana Daniel also mentioned the S. Main Street project and the completion of the 98 By-Pass. All three reported on how good the food was. Ms. Simpson stated that she was pleased that the four of them could attend and it was nice of the Town to pay their way. She stated it was a good way for them to understand what their government was up too.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

The first item of business was a follow-up discussion concerning the Concert in the Park event. Ms. Simpson shared the posters with each member and mentioned the time change for the event due to the WFRHS prom. The concert will now be from 3-5 p.m. Two bands are lined up: Graffiti Monkeys and Bulletproof. Both bands are \$200 each. Brian Pate will furnish the sound for the concert at a cost of \$500. The total concert price is \$900. Ms. Simpson challenged members to raise at least \$400-\$500 of that cost. The Town will pay the balance. Members liked the posters and flyers furnished by Bill Crabtree. Ms. Simpson suggested that they not post them until after Easter so that students would forget with a long lead time. Each member stated that they would be at the concert ready to help in any way.

The next item of business was sub-committee reports for the spring concert. The fund-raising committee gave a list of the businesses they had been to or were going to visit. Several members stated that they felt confident that they could raise the amount Ms. Simpson spoke of. The band committee has finished their job. The publicity committee stated that they would continue to work with Mr. Crabtree to see that information went out to newspapers, schools, website, as well as other avenues.
