TOWN SEEKS CEMETERY & URBAN FORESTRY ADVISORY BOARD CANDIDATES

WAKE FOREST, NC – December 23, 2008 – The Town of Wake Forest is seeking applicants living in Wake Forest or within its extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ) to fill seats on the Cemetery and Urban Forestry Advisory Boards.

One unexpired term, which expires Dec. 31, 2009, is available on the [Cemetery Advisory Board](#) (CAB). The CAB consists of nine members. Its purpose is to advise the Board of Commissioners (BOC) and Town staff in matters affecting cemetery policies and improvements. Members serve three-year terms and are appointed by the BOC. The CAB meets at 7 pm on the fourth Tuesday of each month in the Board Chambers at Town Hall, 401 Elm Ave.

One unexpired term, which expires Dec. 31, 2009, is available on the [Urban Forestry Advisory Board](#) (UFAB). The UFAB consists of nine members who oversee the Town's Urban Forestry Program, including the Town's annual Arbor Day Program and planting events. The UFAB also advises the BOC on policies relating to trees and landscape regulations. Members serve three-year terms and are appointed by the BOC. The UFAB meets at 7 pm on the second Monday of each month at the Planning Office Annex, 205 S. Brooks St.

Any citizen living in Wake Forest or within its ETJ who is interested in serving on one of these advisory boards may obtain an application by contacting Town Clerk Joyce Wilson, MMC, at (919) 554-6190 or jwilson@wakeforestnc.gov or by visiting the Town's website at www.wakeforestnc.gov/Government/AdvisoryBoards.aspx.

The BOC will interview candidates during its work session on Tuesday, Feb. 3, 2009, at 5:30 pm. Advisory board appointments will be announced during the Feb. 17, 2009, BOC

meeting. All advisory board meetings are open to the public.
