WAKE FOREST TOWN HALL GROUNDBREAKING MAY 22

WAKE FOREST, NC – May 9, 2008 – Town of Wake Forest officials will break ground on the new Wake Forest Town Hall on Thursday, May 22 at 10 a.m.

Area residents are invited to attend the groundbreaking ceremony set to take place at the corner of Brooks Street and Owen Avenue, across from the Wake Forest Planning Department, 221 S. Brooks St. Parking for the event will be available in the current town hall parking lot, as well as along Brooks Street and Owen Avenue.

Construction for the new four-story, 44,000 square foot facility is expected to begin later in May. The Town is moving forward with the project now that the bid for construction of the building was awarded to Heaton Construction. The estimated date for completion of the new town hall is October 2009.

Speakers at the groundbreaking event will include Wake Forest Mayor Vivian Jones and Town Manager Mark Williams. Renderings of the building will be on display and the ceremonial shoveling of dirt will occur. A reception with light refreshments will follow the brief ceremony.
