PHONE BOOK RECYCLING

WAKE FOREST, NC – April 21, 2009 – Wake Forest residents and business owners can recycle their outdated phone books by dropping them off at the Town of Wake Forest Operations Center, located at 234 Friendship Chapel Road.

Residents can recycle their directories in any of the co-mingled paper containers at the Operations Center, which will serve as a permanent 24-hour-a-day drop-off location. A sign at the entrance of the facility will direct residents to the designated receptacles.

The telephone books recycled in Wake County will be used to make environmentally friendly insulation for houses, mulch for gardens, egg cartons, and a variety of assorted paper products, such as utility bill envelopes, cereal boxes, and grocery bags.
