TOWN SEEKS CANDIDATES FOR HUMAN RELATIONS COUNCIL

WAKE FOREST, NC – April 29, 2009 – The Town of Wake Forest is seeking applicants living in Wake Forest or within its extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ) to fill two in-town seats on the Human Relations Council (HRC). The term for one seat expires Dec. 31, 2009, while the other ends Dec. 31, 2011.

The HRC consists of nine members whose duties are to encourage understanding and good will between all citizens regardless of race, sex, religion, creed, nationality, or economic status, and thus promote the general welfare of the town. The HRC meets at 7 pm on the fourth Thursday of each month at various locations throughout Wake Forest. All advisory board meetings are open to the public.

Any citizen living in Wake Forest or within its ETJ who is interested in serving on the HRC may obtain an application by calling (919) 554-6190, contacting the HRC via email at hrc@wakeforestnc.gov, or visiting the Town's website at www.wakeforestnc.gov/Government/AdvisoryBoards.aspx.

The Board of Commissioners will interview candidates during its work session on Tuesday, June 2, 2009, at 5:30 pm. Advisory board appointments will be announced during the June 16, 2009, BOC meeting.
