CHARITY SOFTBALL TOURNEY APRIL 10

WAKE FOREST, NC – April 6, 2010 – The Wake Forest Police and Fire Departments are joining forces with several area police and fire agencies to raise money for the 200 Club of Wake County by participating in a charity softball tournament on April 10. The games get underway at 9 a.m. and will be played at Flaherty Park, 1226 N. White St.

According to its website, the 200 Club of Wake County is an organization of concerned citizens dedicated to providing immediate financial help for the spouse and children of police officers, sheriff deputies, firemen, EMS squad members and North Carolina State Highway Patrol serving in Wake County who lose their life in the line of duty.

In addition to the Wake Forest Police and Fire Departments, the softball tournament will include public safety units from Rolesville, Knightdale, Wendell, and Zebulon.

The winning team in the one-day tournament will not only enjoy bragging rights among the area's public safety agencies, it will also earn the right to retain the tournament trophy for the remainder of the year.

Admission to the tournament is free, but donations will be accepted. Any business that makes a contribution – regardless of the amount - will be allowed to provide a banner to be hung on the outfield fence throughout the entire day of the tournament.

A concession stand offering hamburgers, hotdogs, and soft drinks for sale will be provided throughout the day on Saturday. All concession sales proceeds will be donated to the 200 Club of Wake County.
