### **EVENING ROAD WORK CONTINUES ALONG SOUTH MAIN STREET**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – June 22, 2010** – The portion of US 1A/South Main Street from Farm Road to Forestville Road will be reduced to one lane from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. each weeknight over the next two weeks while the contractor lays asphalt and pours curbing.

Motorists in the area should use caution, obey flag signals from construction personnel, and use an alternate route if possible.

The lane closure has been scheduled in the evenings in order to perform the work during off-peak travel times, which will minimize the impact on area drivers.

The US 1A/South Main Street Roadway Widening Project extends along US 1A/South Main Street from Farm Road to Forestville Road. Upon completion, this half-mile corridor will expand to a three-lane curb and gutter section with four-foot bike lanes on both sides of US 1A/South Main Street and a sidewalk along the left-hand side of the road (traveling towards downtown). Construction is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2010.

The Town of Wake Forest appreciates the continued patience of citizens while construction on this project continues.
