### **EVENING ROAD WORK TO CONTINUE WEEK OF JUNE 7 ALONG US 1A/SOUTH MAIN STREET**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – June 4, 2010** – Motorists should continue to expect delays along US 1A/South Main Street every evening during the week of June 7 while work crews continue installing the storm drain crossings as part of the US 1A/South Main Street Roadway Widening Project. This phase of the project was expected to be finished this week, but inclement weather delayed its completion and forced the revised work schedule.

Weather permitting, the work will get underway at 7 p.m. each evening and conclude the following morning at 6 a.m. US 1A/South Main Street will remain open during these times but will be reduced to one lane while the work is being performed. Motorists in the area should use caution, obey flag signals from construction personnel, and use an alternate route if possible.

The night time installation of the storm drain crossings has been scheduled in order to perform the work during off-peak travel times, which will minimize the impact on area drivers.

The US 1A/South Main Street Roadway Widening Project extends along US 1A/South Main Street from Farm Road to Forestville Road. Upon completion, this half-mile corridor will expand to a three-lane curb and gutter section with four-foot bike lanes on both sides of US 1A/South Main Street and a sidewalk along the left-hand side of the road (traveling towards downtown). Construction is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2010.

The Town of Wake Forest appreciates the continued patience of citizens while construction on this project continues.
