WAKE FOREST, NC – April 3, 2012 – You can make a difference in our community by applying to fill one of the vacancies on the Planning Board, Human Relations Council, Cemetery Advisory Board, or Board of Adjustment.

The Town's advisory boards were established to give citizens input into what happens in the community and to advise the Board of Commissioners on matters that affect citizens and their Town government.

Completed applications will be accepted until 5 p.m., Monday, April 23, and may be mailed or delivered to Town Clerk Deeda Harris, Wake Forest Town Hall, 301 S. Brooks St., Wake Forest, NC 27587 or faxed to (919) 435-9419.

The Board of Commissioners will meet the candidates during its regular work session on Tuesday, May 1, and will announce the advisory board appointments during its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, May 15. Terms for the new appointees will commence immediately.

Applicants for the Cemetery Advisory Board and the Human Relations Council must meet with the respective boards prior to the Board of Commissioners May 1 work session. The Cemetery Advisory Board meets on Tuesday, April 24, while the next Human Relations Council meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 26. Both meet at 7 p.m. in the ground floor meeting room at town hall, 301 S. Brooks St.
