INDEPENDENCE DAY HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

WAKE FOREST, NC – June 13, 2012 – The Wake Forest Town Hall and other administrative offices will be closed Wednesday, July 4, in observance of the Independence Day holiday. Garbage, recycling, and yard waste collection will also be suspended. Police service will not be interrupted.

Wake Forest bus service, including the Wake Forest-Raleigh Express and the Wake Forest Loop, will not be provided July 4 but will resume its normal schedule Thursday, July 5.

The collection of garbage and recycling for the week of July 2 will change as follows:

Wednesday	Thursday, July 5
Thursday	Friday, July 6
Friday	Saturday, July 7

Yard waste will not be collected on Wednesday, July 4. The collection of all routes, including Wednesday's route, will occur throughout the week until all have been completed.

In order to ensure that all neighborhoods are serviced properly, residents should place yard waste at the curb by 7 a.m. on Monday for pick-up by Friday. Please avoid placing items on or near mailboxes, utility boxes, utility poles, or other fixed objects.

Town offices will re-open Thursday, July 5, at 8 a.m.
