Two Days of Elite Baseball Training for All Levels of Players!

The Wake Forest Parks & Recreation Department will offer a baseball clinic for youths ages 7 to 14 on Friday, July 10 from 6 pm to 8 pm and Saturday, July 11 from 9 am to 11:30 am and 12:30 am to 2 pm. An instructional game will follow from 2 pm to 4 pm. *Participants must bring their own lunch if they plan to attend both Saturday sessions.* Wake Forest-area youths are invited to join Rick Lancellotti and his traveling instructors from the Buffalo School of Baseball (BSB), Buffalo, NY, as they pay a special visit to Wake Forest to teach the fundamentals of hitting, pitching, fielding, baserunning, positioning, and situations.

Cost

The total cost for the two-day clinic is \$75.

Location

The clinic will be held at the Flaherty Park baseball fields, 1226 N. White St.

The baseball clinic is limited to 100 participants. The deadline to register is July 1. Rick Lancellotti began his 17-year professional baseball career in 1977. He played in 15 leagues, seven countries (US, Canada, Japan, Italy, Venezuela, Mexico and Columbia) and over 100 cities nationwide, ranging from Maine to Hawaii. Rick played for the Buffalo Bisons, winning the AA Eastern League MVP in 1979. He is a member of the Major League Baseball Players Association and the Major League Alumni Association. Rick finished his career as the all-time active minor league home run leader with 276 home runs. Rick has instructed and given clinics to students of all ages throughout the US, Japan and Italy. Since 1993, Rick and the BSB staff have been providing private instruction and instructional clinics for baseball and softball players of all ages and are bringing their expertise to a town near you.
