TOWN SEEKS ADVISORY BOARD CANDIDATES TO FILL UNEXPIRED TERMS

WAKE FOREST, NC – June 15, 2009 – Numerous opportunities exist for Wake Forest citizens to become actively involved in the town's development. Issues related to various interests are reviewed by appointed citizen boards before action is taken by the Wake Forest [Board of Commissioners](#).

Due to a number of recent member resignations, applicants who live inside the Wake Forest town limits are sought to fill the following unexpired advisory board seats:

Cemetery Advisory Board

Applicants are sought to fill one in-town seat which expires Dec. 31, 2010. The Cemetery Advisory Board consists of nine members. Its purpose is to advise the Board of Commissioners and Town staff in matters affecting cemetery policies and improvements. The Cemetery Advisory Board meets at 7 pm on the fourth Wednesday of each month in the Board Chambers at Town Hall.

Human Relations Council

Applicants are sought to fill two in-town seats which expire Dec. 31, 2009, and Dec. 31, 2011, respectively. The Human Relations Council (HRC) consists of nine members whose duties are to encourage understanding and good will between all citizens regardless of race, sex, religion, creed, nationality, or economic status, and thus promote the general welfare of the Town. The HRC meets at 7 pm on the fourth Thursday of each month at various locations throughout Wake Forest.

All members of these advisory boards are appointed by the Board of Commissioners.
