FINAL WEEK TO PURCHASE ENGRAVED BRICK PAVER

WAKE FOREST, NC – June 15, 2009 – The Town of Wake Forest is reminding area residents, businesses, and civic clubs that the last day to purchase an engraved brick paver is Friday, June 19.

To date, over 230 Wake Forest residents, former residents, merchants, churches, civic groups and others have purchased a brick paver in support of Wake Forest's 2009 Centennial Celebration.

The brick pavers measure 4" x 8", include up to three lines for engraving, and can be purchased for \$100. Order forms are available online at www.wakeforestnc.gov/2009centennial_brickpavers.aspx or at Town Hall.

Anyone who buys a brick paver before June 19 can participate in the creation of Centennial Plaza by ensuring their brick will be installed during the initial phase of construction of the new town hall. Centennial Plaza will be located just outside the new town hall and will serve as a focal point of the new municipal campus.

Wake Forest has been selling engraved pavers to residents and businesses for the past several months. Purchasers have submitted personalized inscriptions honoring loved ones, marking special events, and recognizing civic clubs and social groups. These special messages will be viewed and enjoyed by visitors to Centennial Plaza for years to come and will effectively link Wake Forest's past with its present and future.
