SCHEDULE CHANGES ANNOUNCED FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT'S FINGERPRINTING SERVICE

WAKE FOREST, NC – August 25, 2009 – In July the Wake Forest Police Department began offering live scan fingerprinting to the general public on Thursdays between 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. Due to staff training exercises scheduled over the next several weeks, the service will not be provided on the following dates: Aug. 27, Sept. 3, and Oct. 8.

Aside from these dates the police department will continue offering the service to the general public according to the normal schedule.

The cost is \$10 for Wake Forest residents and \$15 for non-residents. Cash, check, and credit cards are accepted, but payment must be made at the Wake Forest Town Hall customer service window before the fingerprinting service will be rendered. A valid picture ID is required for identification.

The live scan fingerprinting, also known as electronic fingerprinting, is performed at the Wake Forest Police Department, 225 S. Taylor St., which is located adjacent to the Wake Forest Town Hall, 401 Elm Ave.
