JULIE LUDDY WINS ANTHEMION AWARD

WAKE FOREST, NC – September 3, 2009 – The Town of Wake Forest is pleased to announce that Julie Luddy is the recipient of a 2009 Anthemion Award for the renovation of the Royall-Luddy House, 339 N. Main St., formerly known as the Royall-Braswell House.

The Anthemion Award is granted each year by Capital Area Preservation (CAP). It recognizes and honors outstanding dedication and commitment to excellence in historic preservation in Wake County.

Robert Royall constructed the Royall-Luddy House around 1900. The Queen Anne-style residence is a two-story, side-gabled house that includes a gable roof covered with slate in alternating bands of rectangular and fish scale tiles. The first story wrap-around porch features paired and tripled chamfered posts with sawn work brackets and a railing with a unique arched design.

Other notable features of the home include a one-story bay window with turned lath decoration and a front entrance that features carved, double wooden doors and etched glass lights.

The Anthemion Awards will be presented during a special a cocktail/hors d'oevres reception on Tuesday, Sept. 15 beginning at 5:45 pm at Cafe Luna, 136 East Hargett St. in Raleigh. Admission to the event is by ticket only. Tickets are available for \$10 in advance and \$20 at the door.
