HISTORIC HOME TOUR – CHRISTMAS IN WAKE FOREST 2010

WAKE FOREST, NC – November 2, 2010 – The Wake Forest Historic Preservation Commission and the Wake Forest Woman's Club will present their biennial Christmas Historic Home Tour on Saturday, Dec. 4, from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m.

The Christmas Historic Home Tour is only offered in even-numbered years, but this year's edition promises to be one of the biggest and best ever. Approximately 14 homes, churches, and other buildings will be decorated for the holidays and open for viewing as part of the self-guided tour. In addition, the college carillon will play holiday music, free bicycle rickshaw and horse drawn carriage rides will be offered, and the Wake Forest Historical Museum, the Stone Chapel, and Wake Forest Baptist Church will provide live music performances.

Advance tickets may be purchased online at www.wakeforestnc.gov/marketplace.aspx for \$12/each through Wednesday, Dec. 1. Tickets will also go on sale later this week at various locations in downtown Wake Forest, including the Wake Forest Town Hall, 301 S. Brooks St. Tickets cost \$15/each on the day of the tour. Well-mannered children 12 and under will be admitted free.
