**PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS PHASE II
STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM SET FOR DEC. 1**

WAKE FOREST, NC – November 23, 2010 – The Town of Wake Forest has scheduled a public meeting on Wednesday, Dec. 1, at 2 p.m. to gather input on its Phase II Stormwater Management Program. The meeting will be held in the ground floor meeting room of Town Hall, located at 301 S. Brooks St.

The Phase II Stormwater Management Program details the proposed plan for the five-year term of Wake Forest's Phase II National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The overall goal of the Phase II permit is to adopt stormwater control policies, strategies, and rules designed to protect North Carolina's surface waters from impacts of stormwater pollutants and run-off volumes.
