**DROP OFF LOCATION ANNOUNCED
FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT TURKEY DRIVE**

WAKE FOREST, NC – November 4, 2010 – The organizer of this year’s Police Department Turkey Drive announced today that donations are now being accepted at the new police substation, located at 221 S. Brooks St. Situated adjacent to Centennial Plaza, the facility housed the Town’s planning department prior to the opening of the new town hall.

According to Det. M.W. Sattler, the Brooks Street substation will serve as the police department’s only Turkey Drive drop-off location. Area residents and businesses can deliver monetary donations, gift cards, and frozen turkeys to the substation on weekdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. through Friday, Nov. 19.

All monetary contributions and gift cards will be used to purchase additional turkeys. Checks should be written to the Wake Forest Police Department.

The turkeys will be distributed on Tuesday, Nov. 23, between 8 a.m. and noon, at the Wake Forest Community House, 133 W. Owen Ave.
