CROSSWALK REPAIR RESCHEDULED AT SOUTH MAIN STREET/DURHAM ROAD ROUNDABOUT

WAKE FOREST, NC – June 1, 2010 – The crosswalk repair in the vicinity of the South Main Street/Durham Road roundabout originally scheduled for June 1-2 has been re-scheduled for June 3-4.

As a result, motorists should expect traffic delays in the vicinity of the South Main Street/Durham Road traffic circle on Thursday and Friday this week (June 3-4), while work crews repair the crosswalk that extends across the South Main Street roundabout entrance. Weather permitting, the work will get underway each morning at 9 a.m. and conclude at approximately 3 p.m.

The Town of Wake Forest will temporarily close the southbound lane from Durham Road to South Main Street while the work is being performed. During the closing, flaggers will be on hand to direct traffic around the work site.

Motorists from the west are advised to take South Wingate Street to West Vernon Avenue as an alternate route, while motorists from the east should take South Wingate Street or College Street to West Vernon Avenue.

The Town of Wake Forest appreciates the patience of citizens while the crosswalk repairs are performed.
