TOTAL OF 63 CHARGES FILED AGAINST SUSPECTS IN RECENT RASH OF VEHICLE BREAK-INS

WAKE FOREST, NC – June 4, 2010 – Wake Forest Police announced Friday they have filed a total of 63 charges against two local men in connection with a series of vehicle break-ins that occurred in various areas around town in April and May.

Dave McCants, 20, and Timothy Hardy, 16, both of 213 N. Allen Road, Apt. 148, Wake Forest, have each been charged with over 30 assorted counts of burglary, felony breaking and entering a motor vehicle, and larceny from a motor vehicle. Hardy has also been charged with one count of simple larceny.

Both men are presently detained in the Wake County Jail. McCants is being held under \$600,000 secured bond, while Hardy is being held under \$575,000 secured bond.

Police officials say the young men, who mainly targeted unlocked vehicles, were riding stolen bicycles when they committed many of the crimes. The crime spree was finally thwarted on May 19 when Officer S. Woods, while on foot patrol in the vicinity of Massey Apartments, identified three bicycles behind the suspects' apartment that had been reported stolen earlier that day.
