### **ROGERS ROAD NOW OPEN FOLLOWING MID-DAY ACCIDENT**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – June 9, 2010** – The Wake Forest Police Department has re-opened Rogers Road nearly three hours after an accident involving a car and a dump truck.

According to witnesses, the dump truck was traveling east along Rogers Road around noon when the car pulled into its path from Heritage Branch Road. The vehicles collided causing the truck to overturn and its gas tank to rupture.

Officials say a small amount of diesel fuel seeped into the storm drain but the catch basin effectively prevented any of the fuel from entering nearby Smith Creek.

The dump truck driver and the car's driver and passenger were transported by ambulance to Wake Med. No information about their condition is available at this time.
