### **FREE WATER CONSERVATION WORKSHOP AUG. 4**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – July 28, 2010** – The City of Raleigh is sponsoring a free Water Conservation and Efficiency Workshop on Wednesday, Aug. 4, at 6 p.m. The seminar will be held in the Community Meeting Room, located on the ground floor of the new Wake Forest Town Hall. Residents planning to attend the workshop are urged to use the Taylor Street entrance to town hall which runs behind the new facility.

The workshop is designed to help Raleigh's Wake Forest water customers reduce water use and save money following the city's 5 percent rate increase in July. Workshop attendees will learn how to adjust personal water use and detect leaks. Participants will also receive and learn to use assorted water-saving devices.
