**PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS BUS SERVICE  
SET FOR AUG. 31**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – August 4, 2010** – Wake Forest area residents will have the opportunity to offer their input on the Town's bus service during a public meeting on Tuesday, Aug. 31. The meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the ground floor meeting room of town hall, 301 S. Brooks St.

Town staff, along with officials from Capital Area Transit (CAT), will be available to discuss the bus service, including possible modifications to the current schedule. The public is encouraged to attend and offer their feedback regarding the changes and their overall satisfaction with the Town's transit service.

In July 2008 the Town of Wake Forest partnered with Triangle Transit and the City of Raleigh to introduce the transit service, which includes a weekday rush-hour express from downtown Wake Forest to downtown Raleigh and a local circulator service. Over the past year, the local circulator has experienced a 209% increase in ridership, while the number of riders taking the express is up 128%.

Residents planning to attend the meeting are urged to utilize the Taylor Street entrance to the new town hall located in the back of the new facility.
