### **SWIM LESSON REGISTRATION BEGINS JUNE 1**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – May 31, 2011** – Registration for the Wake Forest Parks and Recreation Department's 2011 summer swim lessons sessions begins Wednesday, June 1. Registration is on a first-come, first serve basis and will be held daily at the Wake Forest Town Hall, 301 S. Brooks St., from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until all of the slots are filled.

Four swim lesson sessions will be offered in 2011 for all levels including preschoolers (ages 3-5), beginners (ages 6 and above), and advanced beginners. The 2011 sessions will be held June 19-30; July 11-21; July 24 – Aug. 4; and Aug. 8-18. Classes meet Monday through Thursday for two weeks, 45 minutes per day. Classes are conducted rain or shine and are only cancelled in the event of thunderstorms and/or lightning.

Swim lessons are provided by a single instructor to groups with a minimum of four students and a maximum of eight participants per class.

The cost is \$35 for Wake Forest residents who reside within the Town limits and \$70 for non-residents.
