## **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR WAKE FOREST CEMETERY WALKING TOUR**

**WAKE FOREST, NC – January 25, 2012** – The Wake Forest Cemetery Advisory Board is seeking local history buffs who enjoy sharing stories about colorful characters from the town's past to serve as volunteer docents for this year's Cemetery Walking Tour.
