HRC OFFERS COMMUNITY OUTREACH NIGHT MARCH 22

WAKE FOREST, NC – March 13, 2012 – The Wake Forest Human Relations Council (HRC) is sponsoring its first Community Outreach Night of 2012 on Thursday, March 22, from 7 to 8 p.m. The program will be held at the Wake Forest Presbyterian Church, 12605 Capital Blvd.

All residents in northwest Wake Forest who live west of Capital Boulevard/US 1 are invited to attend, meet local officials, and learn more about Town programs and services. This area includes, but is not limited to, Crenshaw Manor, Crenshaw Hall, St. Ives, Prestwicke, Riverstone, the Wake Forest Country Club, Country Club Downs, Fairlake, and the Club Villas.

The session gets underway with a panel discussion that includes Mayor Vivian Jones, Town Manager Mark Williams, and Planning Director Chip Russell. Panelists will share information about Wake Forest's opportunities and challenges in 2012 and beyond.

The HRC is one of 11 Town of Wake Forest advisory boards. Its purpose is to encourage understanding and good will between all Wake Forest citizens regardless of race, sex, religion, creed, nationality, or economic status, and thus promote the general welfare of the Town. The HRC plans to schedule similar community outreach events throughout 2012 for residents in other areas of Wake Forest.
