SIX SUNDAYS IN SPRING SET TO KICK OFF APRIL 29

WAKE FOREST, NC – April 23, 2012 – From folk rock to jazz and bluegrass to soul, there's something for all music lovers at this year's Six Sundays in Spring Concert Series. Sponsored by Wake Forest ARTS, the weekly performances get underway Sunday, April 29. The gospel group Millennium Revival Center Praise Team will open the concert at 3 p.m. followed by Marcus Anderson at 5 p.m.

Sunday's performances are part of Wake Forest ARTS' annual spring concert series featuring free, live, outdoor entertainment, artist sales and demonstrations, and food vendors. Six Sundays in Spring offers area residents an opportunity to enjoy a variety of local and regional performers offering enriching cultural experiences.

Other acts scheduled to perform during this year's concert series include Joe Woodson and a Greenways Advisory Board presentation followed by the Will McBride Group on May 6; Phatbread and The Healing Force on May 13; Arielle Bryant followed by Angela Easterling on May 20; Larry Hutcherson opening for John Lakota Locklear on May 27; and The Gravy Boys on June 3.

All concerts begin at 3 p.m. and are held at E. Carroll Joyner Park, 701 Harris Road. Visitors to the park are reminded that alcoholic beverages, firearms, and unleashed pets are prohibited.
