MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

WAKE FOREST, NC – May 8, 2012 – The Wake Forest Town Hall and other administrative offices will be closed Monday, May 28, in observance of Memorial Day. Garbage, recycling, and yard waste collection will also be suspended May 28.

Wake Forest bus service, including the Wake Forest-Raleigh Express and the Wake Forest Loop, will not be provided May 28 but will resume its normal schedule Tuesday, May 29.

The collection of garbage and recycling for the week of May 28 will change as follows:

Normal Collection Day	Holiday Pick-up Schedule
Monday	Tuesday, May 29
Tuesday	Wednesday, May 30
Wednesday	Thursday, May 31
Thursday	Friday, June 1
Friday	Saturday, June 2

Yard waste collection will resume Tuesday, May 29, at 7 a.m. Crews will follow the normal collection schedule beginning with Monday's route. Collection of the Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday routes will occur throughout the remainder of the week until all routes have been completed. In order to ensure that all neighborhoods are serviced properly, Wake Forest residents are urged to leave their normal yard waste at the curb by 7 a.m. Tuesday, May 29. Please avoid placing items on or near mailboxes, utility boxes, utility poles, or other fixed objects.

Bulk pickups will be scheduled for Wednesday, May 30. To schedule a bulk pickup, call (919) 435-9570 by 2 p.m. Tuesday, May 29. Residents who call after hours may leave a voicemail message that includes their name and physical address. Residents may also request a bulk pickup by emailing bpearce@wakeforestnc.gov.

Town offices will re-open Tuesday, May 29, at 8 a.m.
