**Public Hearings**

When an agenda item is denoted as a [Public Hearing](#), persons attending shall be permitted to address the BOC regarding the item under consideration. Anyone wishing to address the BOC concerning a public hearing item should complete and submit the BOC Public Comment Form on the [Town website](#). Proponents and opponents shall each be given three minutes of time to speak and may choose to allow one speaker to utilize the time. In the event either proponent(s) or opponent(s) have not designated a speaker to represent the view, each speaker will be allowed three minutes each to express his/her comments, ideas, concerns, expressions, and desires. A designated speaker for a group will be allowed 10 minutes to speak. Only comments on a Public Hearing will be allowed during this time.

**Public Comment**

During the Public Comment period, anyone wishing to address the BOC concerning an issue or topic that is not a public hearing item or an agenda item should complete and submit the BOC Public Comment Form on the [Town website](#). Then, during the Public Comment portion of the meeting, Mayor Jones will recognize you and invite you to the podium at which time you will have three minutes to speak.
