Case No. TA-20-06 - Consideration of a text amendment to the Wake Forest Unified Development Ordinance Case No. RZ-20-08 - Consideration of a zoning map amendment (Rezoning) request filed by the Town of Wake Forest to rezone property located within the Glen Royall Mill Village Historic District, Generally north of E. Cedar St., west of the Railroad, south of Hill St., and east of N. Main Street from Urban Residential (UR) and Conditional Use Urban Residential (CU UR) to General Residential 5 (GR 5) and Glen Royall Mill Village Character Preservation Overlay District (MVCP-O).
