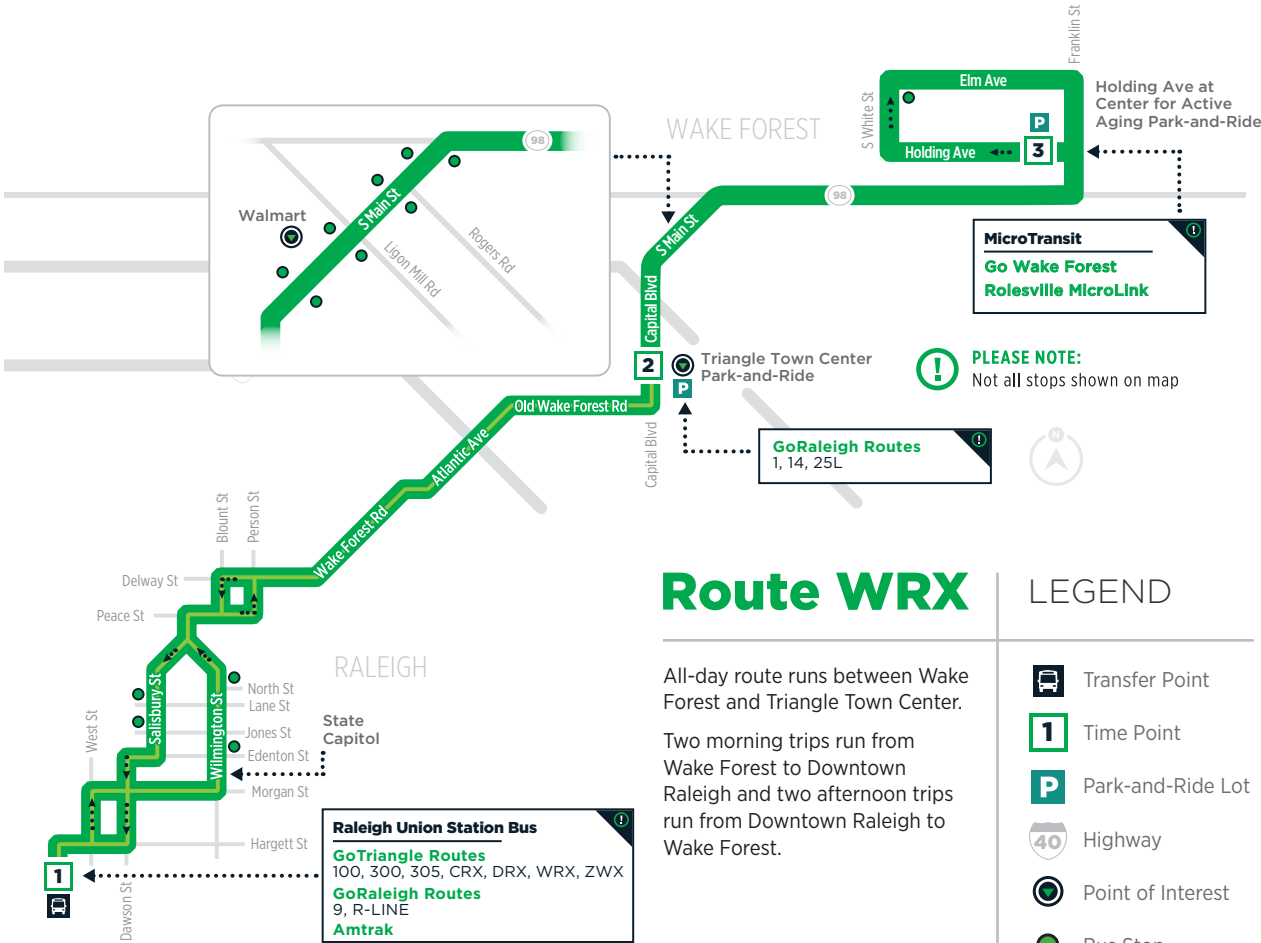

Fixed-Route Fare Options

Route WRX

All-day route runs between Wake Forest and Triangle Town Center.

Two morning trips run from Wake Forest to Downtown Raleigh and two afternoon trips run from Downtown Raleigh to Wake Forest.

Fare Capping

Fare caps are the maximum amount a rider would pay in a given period of time using your GoPass.

Discounts

- Children ages 12 and younger ride free with an adult.
- Youth ages 13-18 can qualify for free fare. (Without qualifying, youth pay the discounted fare.)
- Seniors age 65 and older can qualify for free fare.
- Passengers with disabilities can qualify for discounted fare.
- Transit Assistance Pass (TAP).

Umo App / GoPass Card

With the Umo app, you can plan your trips, track your bus, and pay all in one place. Download the Umo Mobility app for convenient, digital ticketing.

No smartphone? No problem! Physical Umo GoPass cards can be picked up at the Pass Sales Office at the Regional Transit Center in Durham, or at the GoRaleigh Station, 214 S. Blount St., Raleigh. 919-485-7433.

How to Load Value

IN PERSON:

- Pass Sales Office** at the Regional Transit Center and RUS Bus: Mon-Fri, 6 am-6:30 pm; Sat-Sun, 7 am-3 pm. 919-485-7433.
- Umo Retail Locations:** Load funds onto your Umo app or GoPass card at various retail locations within a mile of a GoTriangle bus stop. Visit [GoTriangle.org/add-funds](https://www.gotriangle.org/add-funds) to see all retail locations.

**Smoking is not allowed on GoTriangle vehicles.** Smoking and/or the use of vapor products, including e-cigarettes, is not permitted on GoTriangle vehicles, at bus stops, and city-owned sidewalks within Orange, Durham, and Wake County.



**Safe Place.** GoTriangle vehicles are Safe Places for anyone in need of immediate help and safety.

ADA / Paratransit Services



**GoTriangle Access** is a regional curb-to-curb paratransit service (with a door-to-door option, upon request) for eligible residents of Wake, Durham and Orange counties. The service is designed for people with disabilities that prevent them from using the GoTriangle fixed-route bus service. A trip must begin and end within three-quarters of a mile of a GoTriangle all-day fixed-route bus service.



**GoWake Access** provides door-to-door, shared ride transportation services to those in the general public who are age 60 or older, have a disability, need work-related transportation, reside in rural Wake County, and/or participate in a sponsord eligible service (Medicaid, Public Health, Work First).



**GoRaleigh Access** paratransit is available for ADA eligible riders to a transfer point. For trip requests originating in Wake Forest, rides may be booked with a local taxi company partner (standard taxi rates may apply) or with Go Wake Forest to the transfer point.

## How to book a ride



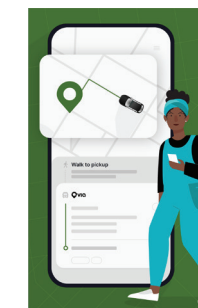
### 1. Create an account.

Download the Go Wake Forest app from the App Store or Google Play Store and follow the simple signup steps.



### 2. Book a ride.

Enter your pickup and dropoff addresses. Choose the ride that works best for you and tap **Book This Ride**.



### 3. Meet your driver.

Check the app to see when your driver will arrive. If you have mobility needs, call 984-342-2319 or fill out the request form on the Go Wake Forest website.

## How do I get to Raleigh?

Request a Go Wake Forest ride to the Wake Forest-Raleigh Express (WRX) bus stop in Downtown Wake Forest.

This ADA accessible bus service departs from the Wake Forest Center for Active Aging (235 E Holding Ave, Wake Forest) to the Raleigh Union Bus Station (525 W Hargett St, Raleigh). See other side of this brochure for details.

Eligible ADA riders for paratransit service can also get to Raleigh by connecting to **GoRaleigh Access** in one of two ways:

1. Schedule a **GoRaleigh Access** ride to Raleigh by calling 919-996-3459 no less than 24 hours prior to your trip. The portion of travel between your trip origin in Wake Forest and the GoRaleigh Access service boundary will be operated by a local taxi company partner (standard taxi rates may apply). Once the taxi service reaches the GoRaleigh Access service boundary, your trip will transition to an ADA trip within the GoRaleigh Access Zone.
2. Alternatively, in lieu of a taxi, riders can book a Go Wake Forest ride to the Sheetz gas station by Capital Blvd (4801 Thornton Rd, Raleigh), where you can transition to a GoRaleigh Access vehicle. Note: 24-hour advance coordination with GoRaleigh Access is still required.

## Connecting to Rolesville



**MicroLink** is an on-demand curb-to-curb microtransit service that operates in the Town of Rolesville with connections to destinations in Wake Forest. This service is operated by GoRaleigh.
