Driveway Permit Submittal Checklist

A Driveway Permit is a type of Development Permit (15.6.1) and indicates compliance with the provisions of the Wake Forest Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). A driveway permit is required for the construction or relocation of residential driveways within the Town of Wake Forest jurisdiction. Additional requirements for driveways are within Chapter 9 of the UDO, Town MSSD and the detail sheet. If modifications are requested to a commercial driveway, please contact the Planning Department to determine the appropriate application type.

Α	Sketch Plan
1	A Sketch Plan shall be provided to accurately reflect the nature of the application. The Sketch Plan shall show in simple sketch form the shape and dimensions of the lot on which the proposed use is to be constructed as well as all information listed below:
	i. North Arrow and Scale not less than 1" = 50'
	ii. Layout of existing streets and curbs
	iii. Property lines and dimensions
	iv. Building(s) location
	v. Environmental Conditions (Special Flood Hazard Areas, Wetlands, Etc.)
	vi. Public or private easements and buffer areas
	vii. Label setbacks and dimensions at right-of-way and from property lines
	viii. Existing/proposed driveway expansion
	ix. Location of existing/proposed storm drainage inlets along curb, including adjacent lots
	x. Location of existing/proposed score joints
	xi. Label existing/proposed curb radius and flare, if applicable
	xii. Location and size of driveway pipe, if applicable
	xiii. Label proposed driveway material and thickness
	xiv. Provide existing/proposed Impervious Surface Area

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
