 - O Virtual meetings will suffice, we will ask for someone to be at presentation for BOC in the event there are process questions that can't be answered by staff.  - We can provide shapefile or access to the software for you to export. o
 Includes address, subdivision, unique ID, genus, species, common name,
 condition, growing space, status, DBH and diameter class.
- Does the Town want included in the proposal an in-person presentation of the final plan? Yes, we will ask for a representative when presenting it to the board of commissioners.
